Coop students must attend and complete the synchronous pre-placement session, two integrative sessions and one summative session to earn the credit.

Synchronous learning is learning that happens in real time.

Synchronous learning involves using text, video, or voice communication in a way that enables educators ... to instruct and connect with students in real time.

Synchronous learning supports the well-being and academic achievement of all students, including students with special education needs, by providing educators and students with an interactive and engaging way to learn. It helps teachers provide immediate feedback to students and enables students to interact with one another.
